Short Message

Disruptive rain leading to localized flooding of settlements, roads and low-lying areas is expected along the South Coast and adjacent from tomorrow morning.

Discussion

The cold front is expected to pass through the province tomorrow with a surface high pressure system ridging in behind it. This will result in windy coastal conditions and temperatures dropping significantly across the province. Showers and rain are expected in most places over the province with significant falls along the South Coast and adjacent interior, where localized flooding is possible

Impacts

The disruptive rain is expected to result in localized flooding of susceptible settlements (formal/informal), roads and low-lying areas. Difficult driving conditions and traffic disruptions can also be expected as a result of heavier falls at times.

Instruction

The public is advised to avoid crossing rivers and swollen streams where water is above the ankles. If trapped in a vehicle during a flood try and climb to higher ground. In buildings, move valuables to a safe place above the expected flood level. In rural areas protect/relocate animals to a safe place on higher ground. If the vehicle stalls, leave it and seek higher ground. Be especially cautious on the roads. Listen to the radio or TV for warnings and obey the instructions
